GENERAL: The Adjutant General of Texas invites the nominations of a highly qualified Aviation Branch Warrant Officer to serve as CH-47D instructor pilots for the Republic of Singapore Air Force (RSAF) Training Detachment.

HOW TO APPLY: Title 10 personnel need to send a DA Form 4187, Request for Personnel Action, through channels, to apply. Title 32 AGR and M-day applicants must include a letter of transmittal from State personnel officer, including the following information:

1. DA 160R (Application for Active Duty Packets will not be considered if DA 160R is not signed by applicant.
2. A "CERTIFIED" copy of updated and verified DA Form 2-1 or Officer Record Brief (ORB).
3. Letter of intent to separate from Active Duty or USAR. DD Form 214, if applicable.
4. Copies of four most recent OERs.
5. Copy of most recent SF 88 (Physical Examination). Must have completed and passed HIV Test.
6. Copy of most recent SF 93 (Medical History).
7. Copy of most recent APFT card (DA Form 705) and Body Fat Content Worksheet (DA Form 5500-R).
8. NGB 23A RPAS statement attached to verify creditable Active Federal Service (AFS) and copy of Statement of Service - For computation of Length of Service for Pay Purposes (DA Form 1506).
9. Level of security clearance, type investigation and date completed, agency completing investigation and agency granting current clearance.
10. Number days lump sum leave paid to the applicant since 10 February 1976.
11. Short biographical sketch giving brief personal background and highlighting qualifications for this position.
12. Copies of official college/university transcripts.
13. Written justification of waivers, if required.
14. DA Form 759.
15. Medical Recommendation for Flying Duty (DA Form 4186) is required if currently on flight status.

Brief description of duties and responsibilities include, but are not limited to the following:

1. Pilot CH/IH 47 aircraft under all types of meteorological conditions, both day and night.
2. Perform instructor pilot duties, conduct academic and in-flight aircrew training to personnel assigned to the RSAF Training Detachment.
3. Conduct qualification training, Commander's evaluations, APARTs and no-notice evaluations in CH/IH-47 aircraft.

4. Assist development and management of a performance oriented, technically demanding, standardized Aircrew Training Program (ATP). Assist in the administration of the unit through evaluation, training and technical supervision of unit ATP.

PREREQUISITES:

1. Grade: Warrant Officer (all grades)
2. Branch: AV
3. MOS/SSI: Warrant Officer 154CC/CF/CH
4. Applicant must be CH-47 rated instructor pilot. Instrument Examiner or Standardization Pilot preferred.
5. Military Education: Commensurate with grade.
6. Civilian Education: Commensurate with grade.
7. Must have thorough knowledge of aviation policies, procedures, organizations and operations.
8. Applicants must meet the qualifications listed in Table 2-1, AR 135-18, or be able to qualify for a waiver IAW NGB-ARH Policy Memo #09-021
9. Applicants must meet the height and weight standards of AR 600-9.
10. All selective active and USAR officers will need to voluntarily separate and be assessed into the Texas ARNG prior to accession into the RSAF Flight Training Detachment.
11. Applicants must possess a Secret Security Clearance.
