

Job Title: Red Team Leader/ Member

Duty Description:

Leader or member of a Red Team on a brigade or higher staff operating in support of OIF/OEF. A decision support Red Team is an organizational element comprised of trained and educated members that provide an independent capability to fully explore alternatives in plans and operations in the context of the operational environment and from the perspective of adversaries and others. Red Team members work with other members of the staff to critically examine the group's decision process, offering alternative viewpoints, analyzing assumptions, raising cultural perceptions and critically reviewing staff products during plan development. Red Teams promote horizontal integration across the staff and conduct independent analysis of specific problems as directed by the Commander.

Attend the 9- or 18-week Red Team Leader's Course (RTLTC) at the University of Foreign Military and Cultural Studies (UFMCS), Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. Upon completion of the course, individuals will deploy for a 365-day tour in support of OIF/OEF.

Requirements:

RANK: E8-E9, CW3-CW5, CPT-COL

Civilian Education: Baccalaureate degree or higher

Minimum Security Clearance: Secret

Must be deployable and agree to 365-day deployment upon completion of this course.

Chain of Command approval is required to attend course and follow on deployment. It is the applicant's responsibility to secure this approval.

School is an ATRRS course and applicants must meet the following criteria:

*Officers must be MEL IV qualified or equivalent. (if not completed, waiver is required)

* Senior Captains and Warrant Officers are authorized by exception to attend this course. Each will require a DA G3 and Director UFMCS Approved waiver prior to enrollment.

* Senior Enlisted Personnel (Senior E7, E8 and E9) are authorized by exception to attend this course. Each will require a DA G3 and Director UFMCS Approved waiver prior to enrollment.

* Enlisted Personnel must have completed ANCOC or equivalent to attend this course.

* Be able to read an average of 150 words per minute.

* All Army personnel must take and pass an APFT.
