**GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

Perform complex (Journey-level) work in paint removal from vehicles and other metal substrates. Works with high pressure paint removal equipment utilizing various blast medias. Work with high pressure wash equipment to remove dirt, grease, oils, and blast media in preparation for painting. Reports to the Allied Trades Maintenance Supervisor and works under general supervision with moderate latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgment.

**JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Uses hand and power tools of the trade (i.e. high-water-pressure wash systems, and blaster) to perform duties such as preparing surfaces for painting, erecting and cleaning equipment. Disassembles all types of equipment, in order to blast or remove paint, in preparation for painting.
- Supplies, lifts, and holds materials or tools for shop operations.
- Drives military vehicles, up to and including 10-ton trucks, forklift, sedans or other vehicles to obtain supplies and equipment in connection with the work conducted in the shop.
- Maintains records of materials used.
- Calculates material and labor costs, and orders parts and supplies to complete work orders.
- Works with and assists in training of apprentice-level employees.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

**GENERAL QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS**

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from a standard senior high school or equivalent required.

**EXPERIENCE:**

- Must be a current employee with six months of relevant experience.
- Experience handling a high-pressure-paint-removal system is required.

**PREFERRED:**

- Six months of experience in vehicle body or automotive repair is preferred.
- Six months of experience utilizing hand held air, electrical and hydraulic tools is preferred.

**REGISTRATION, CERTIFICATION OR LICENSURE**

Valid driver's license is required. \*Texas Driver's License will be required within first 30 days of employment. Satisfactory driving records are required for driving state or personal vehicles to conduct agency business.

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES**

- Knowledge of personal protection equipment (PPE) required under OSHA.
- Knowledge of vehicle restoration in the designated work skills, such as vehicle painting, paint removal and automotive metal repair.
- Skill in performing basic math skills.
- Ability to follow instructions and plans in oral and written form.
- Ability to work holidays, weekends, rotating shifts and after duty hours.
- Ability to interpret military technical manuals, illustrations, specifications, diagrams, and similar guides to make repairs and modifications.
- Ability to complete routine jobs and simple preventative maintenance tasks.

**PHYSICAL CONDITIONS**

Incumbent removes coatings from surfaces while on ladders, scaffolds, and platforms. Work may be performed in cramped and hard to reach places. Incumbent will be required to stand, stoop, bend, kneel, climb, and work in tiring and uncomfortable positions. Frequently lifts, carries, and sets up equipment and materials weighing up to 10 pounds. On occasion, may lift materials and equipment that weigh 40 pounds and over.

**WORKING CONDITIONS**

Works inside and outside areas that are usually dusty, dirty, greasy, wet or loud. **Often works outside in inclement weather and may be subject to burns, cuts, scrapes, bruises and broken bones.**
